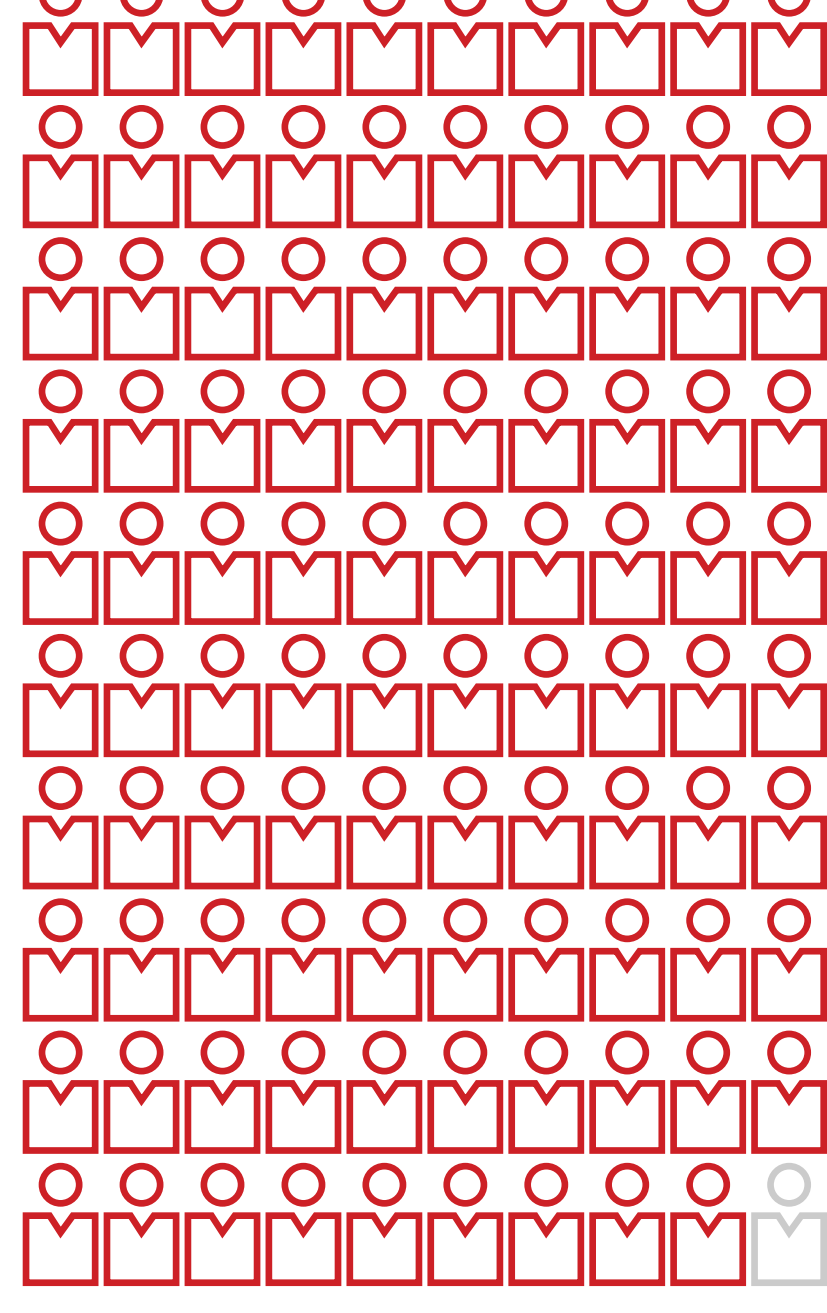


The Federal Data Maturity Report

describe their data maturity as “advanced”



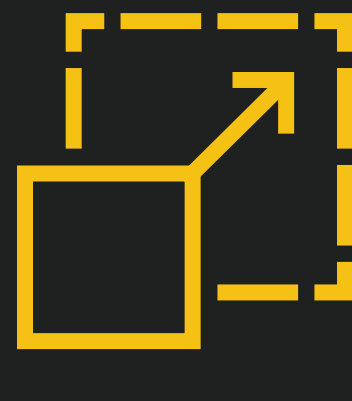
Only 32%

feel their current data infrastructure is being overwhelmed by increasing data volumes

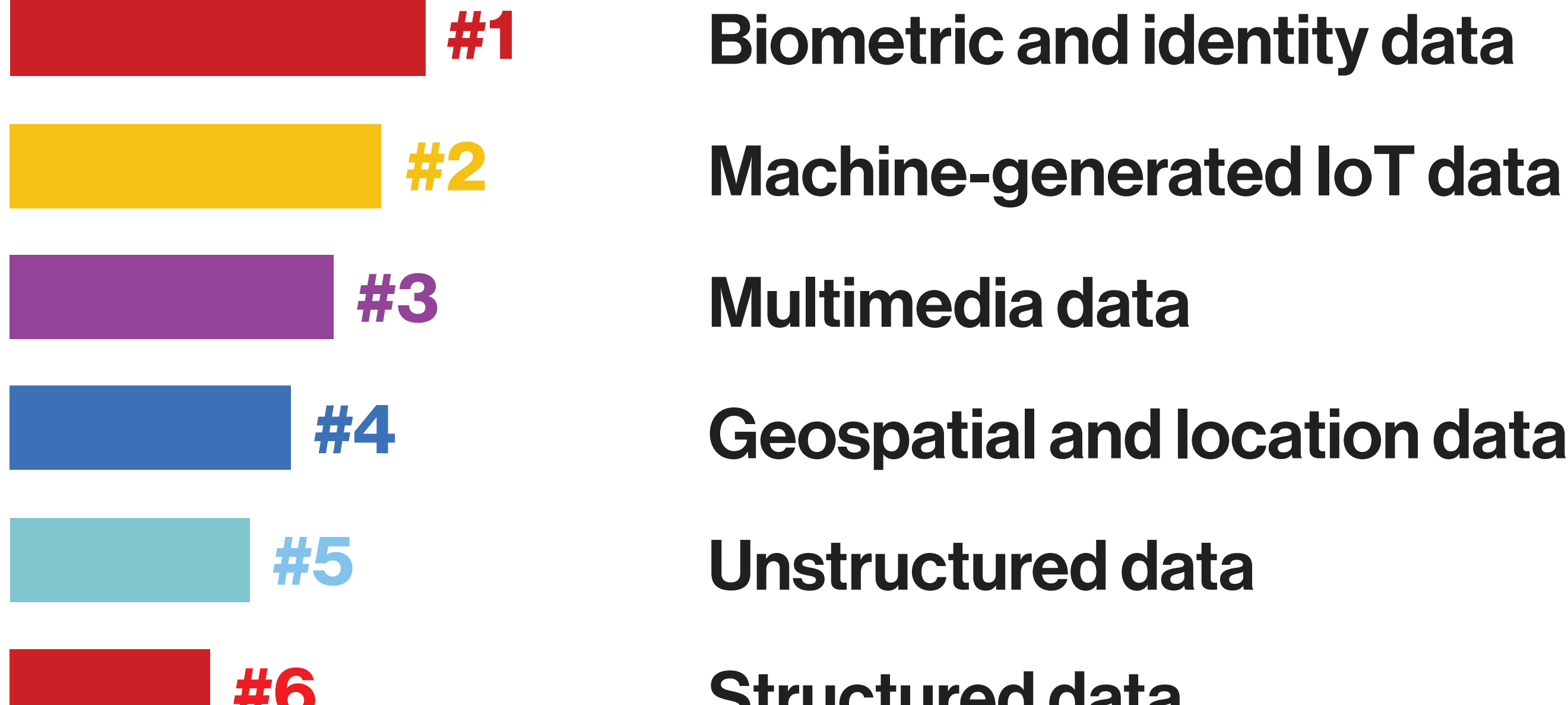

Growth in data volume and complexity is a chief challenge.



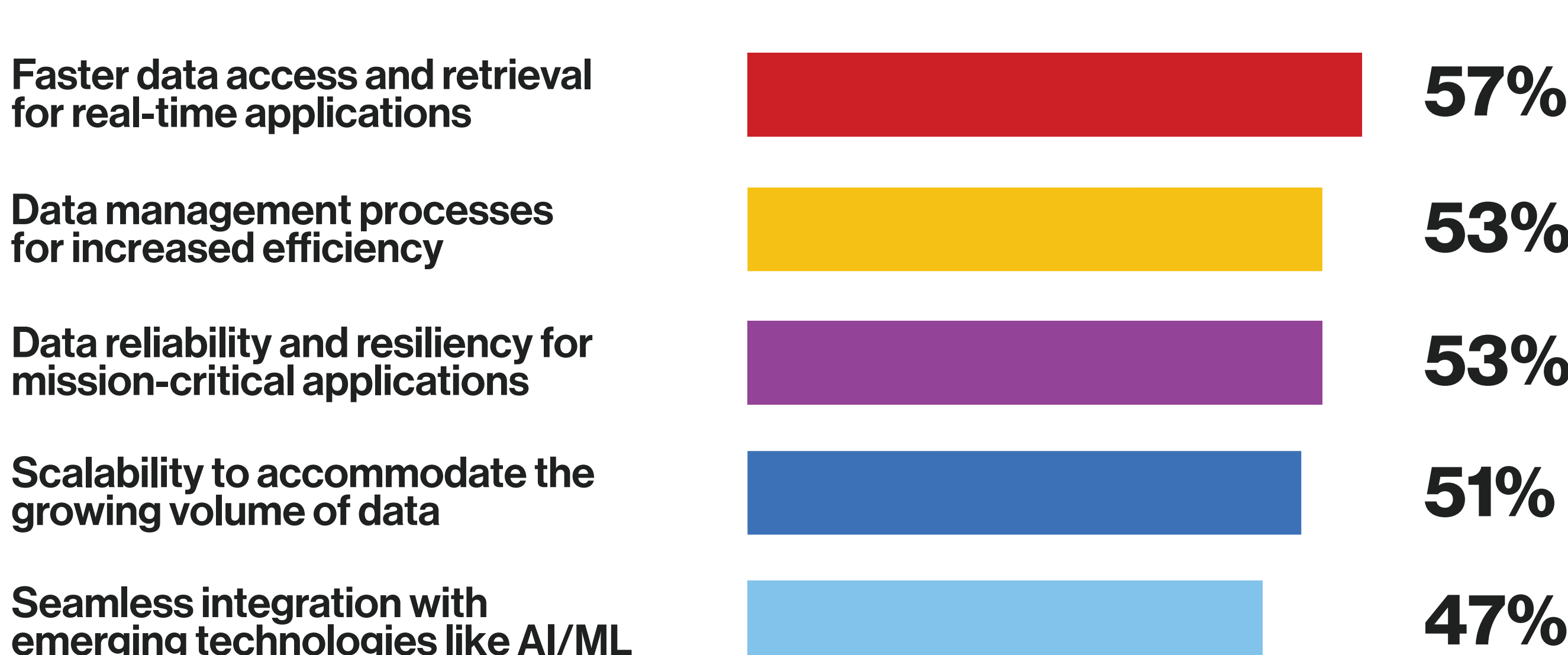
Respondents asked to select all that apply: “What trends have you observed around [growth in] the types of data your organization collects?”
